Congratulations to MFA candidate Daniel Phillips who has received a 2009 IBM Innovation Award for artistic creation in art and technology. One Grand and two Merit Awards were presented to artists in recognition of their work in the 2009 Boston Cyberarts Festival.

Daniel received a Merit Award of \$1000 for his work in “Inherent Tendencies Toward Disorganization.” Over the course of 11 months he set up a camera to take thousands of still images of his studio floor, including his own actions in the space, and then connected these images into a moving animation. The exhibition is on view at the Judi Rotenberg Gallery through June 6.
